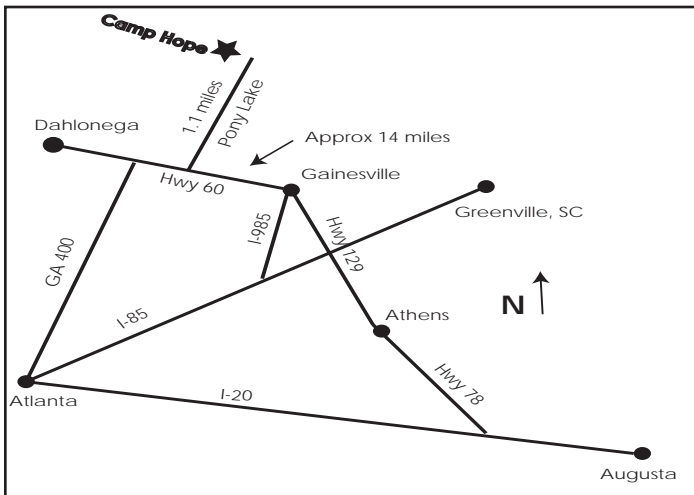

Dress Guidelines

In order to insure that clothing worn by males and females will contribute to the spirit of camp in a positive way by being modest and acceptable, the following information is provided. No spaghetti straps, halter, midriff tops (shirts must cover stomach with arms extended over head), immodest bathing suits, dresses of improper cut, strapless or low-cut tops, front and back. No cleavage should be visible. Ask yourself "Can anyone see down my shirt especially from the front when I bend over?" **Shorts must be of proper fit and no shorter than longest finger when hanging at your side.** Males should not wear ripped out shirts. **This applies to all activities at Camp Hope.**
